

We have put these samples together to highlight some of the great features of our range of **HighGRAB** digital vinyls

All the products in our **HighGRAB** range are fire rated to both EN13501-1 and BS 476 Class 0.

We have compared our **M16-H-K** matt high opacity PVC with **HighGRAB permanent adhesive** with some of our competitors' products, labelled SAMPLE A, B and C and all are major brands with significant UK market share.

We offer a full range of films including monomeric PVC, polymeric PVC, Polyesters and Polypropylenes. All of our products are manufactured in the UK.

These samples highlight some of the positive benefits of our products that you may not currently be aware of. **UV acrylic adhesive:** For maximum adhesion confidence.

Our UV adhesive curing is unique in the UK and offers solvent acrylic performance but with no solvents and no gas intensive drying ovens typically used in adhesive coating. This makes the manufacturing cleaner and requires less energy than traditional solvent or water based adhesive coating.

We calculate our CO₂ emissions are 60% less than those of the standard oven drying operations used by virtually all our competitors.

Our **HighGRAB** adhesive performance against the competition is tabled below for comparison.

Excellent Stability: Our UV adhesive technology results in a finished product that will show less shrinkage, as there are no retained solvents to affect the PVC film.

Our monomerics show similar levels of shrinkage to competitors' polymerics.
